Dear supporters,
Crops have been harvested recently, but unfortunately for many people in Cape Maclear the harvest is again not sufficient.. Most people have food at the moment, but will get through their maize very quickly. The feeding supplement, called Sibusiso, which I use for the feeding program, looks like peanut butter. One jar is sufficient to feed 1 child under the age of 5 years for 2 weeks. Every 8 weeks, we weigh all children and assess them. All 130

children have to cue and stand or sit on the scales. This is every time a big challenge. After being weight, the children get assessed to see if there are any medical problems. I also check if they have reached a normal weight for age and if so, they can be taken off the feeding program.

The pictures below are showing the feeding program.



During my annual leave in Holland I was asked to do a talk about my work in Cape Maclear, Malawi. This was at a gathering of senior people in my home village. Several women knitted clothes for the children in Cape Maclear. I handed these clothes out during the feeding program, as you see in the pictures below.



Over the years people have supported me in many different ways, with medication, money,

fundraising activities, updating the website, etc. It's impossible to say thanks to everybody individually, but I hope by this newsletter I can say thanks for all your help over the last 13 years that I'm working in Cape Maclear, Malawi. I would like to wish everyone happy holidays!!
